To make a strategic difference, SAFP explore solutions for affected people to lead more productive lives with human dignity. SAFP has linked with stakeholders through its research and referring available resources to those in need in and outside the country; SAFP is a part of groups and has initiated discourse on legislative changes within the country, improving understanding on the practical application of laws and policies like UN CESC, UN CRPD in India to improve dignity of persons affected by resource gap and those effected by mental health by advocating for inclusion and better support services.

We work at National level to increase

- Awareness to prevent exclusion by finding community coping solutions in neighborhood settings.
- Avenues for women to lead support services and enterprise to address gender resource gaps.
- Generate discourse on the concept of rehabilitation in mental illness.

**SAFP activities collate learning to build knowledge by sharing it across the world. It works through its partnerships and membership of networks and forums i.e Consult for Women and Land Rights, Alliance on VAW, Food Water Security Coalition India, and National Alliance for Labor Rights. In an attempt to **reduce gender resource gap** SAFP has engaged in training, research, advocacy in 6 states in India and with the Consult For Women and Land Rights members from 20 countries globally.**

**SAFP project **SCAN** (Safe care Aware Neighborhood) works on building relationships to end alienation in two areas in Delhi. SAFP web **resource on mental health** "HUM SATH" is a virtual resource. SAFP plans to set up a physical **center in Kerala** to assist those who have recovered from mental health issues to integrate into the society such that they are performing their personal and community roles as well as living a productive life.**

## BENEFITS OF ENGAGING COMMUNITIES IN DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS

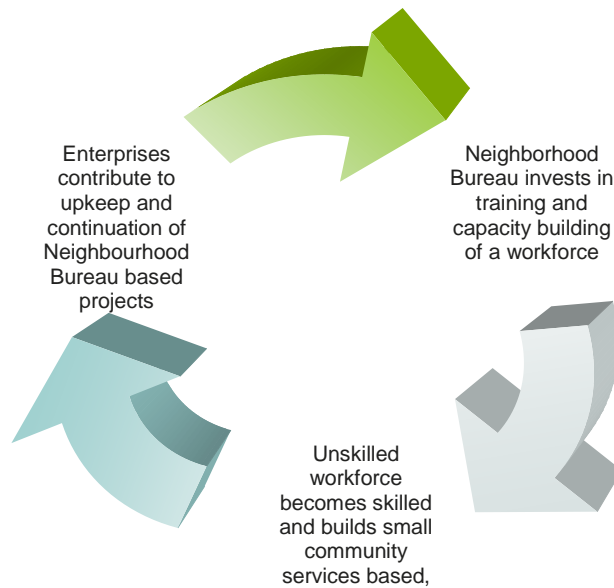
- **Work on CSR Compliance with Government obligation** – 10% of all development space should be allocated to marginalised / existing habitants.
- **Building Social Capital** – Involving communities in development decisions ensures buy-in dignity and security through SCAN program.
- **Asking for workers' centers** for availability of low-skill labor for community and paid services
- **Working women and youth** to manage green spaces, community care amenities/services, cleaning/ cooking facilities, referrals and information.

Corporate organizations under CSR give use rights to productive assets. Suzlon a wind energy company gave use rights for 100 acre agriculture land to vulnerable women in Tamilnadu. Similar efforts gave night shelters to homeless in the city, impact district plan in Kerela and set up over 100 gender resource centers in Delhi. Any project can be a win –win for local neighborhood by including them in the design and upkeep of the property. Interaction and engagement lends security and safety for all.

### A SIMPLE PROCESS

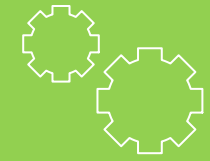
**1** Collect data to establish the level of ownerships of / access to community resources and compare with governance objectives – This may involve using community to collect the information



**2** Through community based discussions and workshops ensure that stakeholders understand their rights to resource and duties to design specific projects full filling needs of the group.

**3** Understand the need and translate into an area development plan or a need specific project with a business plan.

**4** Use elected community leaders to work with Developers, local committees and local planning departments to design and implement a sustainable, gender and generation equal development plan that satisfies the needs of the whole community



### CUSTOM SOLUTIONS

No two areas, persons and communities are the same, Therefore SAFP uses its research base to structure projects to adapt to local and market needs as necessary to provide an area-specific tailor-made solution to use and regenerate resources.
